## Reliable

You can rely on me. Greifswald has developed excellently. Our city is doing very well economically, we are cosmopolitan and innovative, paying attention to social justice and taking responsibility for all generations with sustainable policy.

We have prepared Greifswald well for the future and thus made it a good place to live in – by building 1,400 new apartments, a new school, two new day care centres, five new sports facilities, a large new playground, by redeveloping and creating numerous footpaths and cycling paths, as well as barrier-free bus stops, by establishing two new Sister Cities, by establishing a district management system, by offering social care and home nursing services through SoPHi, by employing social workers working in the neighbourhoods, by rescuing the Theater Vorpommern company, by free entrance to Eldena beach and through new instruments of economic development.

Top positions in national rankings and numerous awards are proof that the path I chose in 2015 is the right one for our city. I would like to continue on this path together with you.

## Social

I want to further develop our city in a social and responsible way: we will build 2,000 new apartments and single homes - in mixed, lively neighbourhoods with playgrounds and sports fields, with local shops and cultural offers. We are establishing a role model school centre „Am Ellernholzteich“ and we will renovate the building of the Humboldt-Gymnasium. We will expand our successful model of the kindergarten kitchens. We want to offer freshly prepared meals in all kindergarten, daycare centers and schools! I will provide sufficient means for youth and social work. To new gymnasiums, the renovation of the Volksstadion and new sports facilities around the Philipp-Müller-Stadion and in the Ostseevierviertel will provide possibilities for everyone. We will consistently continue the digitalization in the education and administration sector.

## Sustainable

Greifswald must be climate-neutral by 2035. Affordable bus transport with tight intervals and newlines, the further development of cycling paths and a railway line connecting Ladebow with Lubmin are going to make mobility sustainable.

District heating and the electricity of our public utility company will come entirely from renewable energies. All public buildings will be built sustainably. Through the use of direct tenant electricity, the energy-efficient renovation of buildings and the use of solar energy we can do without expensive and climate damaging oil and gas. Our city-owned forest, our fields and meadows and our peatlands will contribute to climate protection and at the same time promote the economy. All high-quality products from Greifswald's fields can be processed, marketed and sold here and can be used in the kitchens of our the day care centers.
